What exactly are Permanent Cosmetics?



Permanent Cosmetics, also known as Semi Permanent Make Up or Micro Pigmentation, allow women of all ages (and a growing number of men) to enhance and define their features, creating a beautiful, natural looking finish which will compliment or even replace the use of conventional make up.

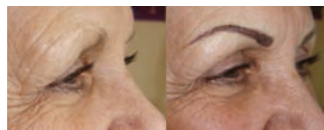
Permanent Make Up is a form of cosmetic tattooing which uses pharmaceutical grade pigment applied to the dermal, or second, layer of skin, ensuring a wonderful shadow of colour which looks exactly like perfectly applied make up.

Unlike conventional make up however, top up treatments are only required every 12 – 18 months to keep your make up looking freshly applied!



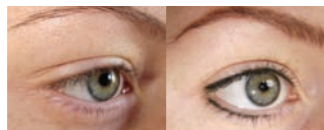
Facial Treatments

Paramedical Treatments (Medical Tattooing)

The following procedures can be particularly helpful following accident, injury or surgery, and are often instrumental in the rebuilding of self confidence



Areola Complex Reconstruction / Pigmentation – This is a particularly effective treatment for patients who have undergone reconstructive breast surgery and who have lost an areola/nipple. Paramedical Permanent Cosmetics allow the creation of a natural looking areola complex through the use of clever shading techniques.

Pigmentation of the Areola may also be carried out for cosmetic reasons where a darker, more defined result is preferred.

Scar Camouflage/Pigmentation – A consultation will be required to assess the extent of scarring and likely, achievable results. More details on request.

Frequently Asked Questions

How long do Permanent Cosmetics last?

Permanent Cosmetics are required to be called “permanent” for legal reasons, as once the pigment is in the system it is there on a permanent basis; however, the effect is semi permanent. A number of factors will determine how long the effect is likely to last:

- Inherited Skin Characteristics
- Whether UVA/UVB protection is worn over treated area
- Whether the treated area is exfoliated
- Certain medications will affect how long your Permanent Cosmetics will last

As a general guide, you should expect to top up your Permanent Cosmetics every 12-18 months to keep the look fresh.

Does it hurt?

The use of state of the art equipment together with sophisticated soothing creams ensures that, for most, the experience is surprisingly comfortable and relaxing.
